
StormTrap and Wieser Concrete Collaborate on Clean Water Solutions

Exciting developments are underway with the Hodgson Road Reconstruction project, stretching from Gramsie Road to Hwy 96 in Vadnais Heights and Shoreview, MN, and slated for completion by Fall 2024. This ambitious initiative by Ramsey County tackles longstanding runoff and flooding issues, significantly boosting local infrastructure and **safety**. At the heart of this project is a state-of-the-art underground stormwater solution featuring 3 SiteSaver STSS-18 units and a 5'-2" SingleTrap system, with a total water storage capacity of 321,126 cubic feet. Pretreatment measured at key inlet locations aim for an "80% reduction of the OK-110 PSD," ensuring cleaner water for the community.







Eureka Construction, Inc. and Wieser Concrete showcased their expertise with a high-quality, swift installation in March and April 2024, managing up to **30 truckloads per day**. Design engineer, Connor Fortune, overcame several challenges, including height and site constraints and the removal of organic material to prepare the foundation.
