Earth, Wind and Trains

The Wieser Concre<mark>te plant in Portage, Wisc, has</mark> been hard at work since August 2023 pouring precast modular retaining T<mark>-Wall® panels destined for</mark> Chicago, III.

The Chicago Region Environmental and Transportation Efficiency (CREATE) Program is a partnership between the U.S. Department of Transportation, State of Illinois, city and county agencies, Metra and Amtrak to improve passenger and freight rail infrastructure. The panels produced by Wieser Concrete are part of the 75th Street Corridor Improvement Project (CIP), and the Forest Hill Flyover and 71st Street Grade Separation phase, portions of a multi-million dollar project to improve road-rail grade separation and traffic transition along two passenger and four freight rail lines. The daily trains affected include 90 freight trains, 30 Metra trains and two Amtrak trains.

The 75th Street CIP is 189,167 SQFT with a total of 4,419 panels. As of 4/25 Wieser Concrete has produced 3,150 panels. At the height of production, 25 panels were produced per day. The panels range in size from 8' to 32' in length and weigh up to 22,500 pounds.
